



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Part # 113, Trailer Tongue Storage Box

Please read and fill out the enclosed warranty registration card to activate your warranty.

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.

Due to the wide variety of mounting configurations and applications the Trailer Tongue Storage Box does not have predrilled mounting holes and is supplied with standard mounting hardware. Shorter or Longer bolts may need to be purchased from your local hardware supplier for your mounting application.

- Place the box in the mounting location.
- Mark bottom of box and drill holes.
- Mark mounting location through holes drilled in box.
- Drill mounting location.
- Bolt down box.
- Check lock operation
- Lock it up!

ATTENTION:

FREQUENT LUBRICATION IS NECESSARY ON THE LOCKING SYSTEM

The pushbutton lock contains an "O" ring seal to protect the interior from dust and water. If this mechanism is not lubricated regularly it will become difficult to operate and it may not return to its home position preventing the key from operating the lock. If this happens simply pull up on the pushbutton to manually bring it back to its home position. Lubricate the pushbutton with a light lubricant such as silicone spray. The pushbutton may have to be periodically disassembled and cleaned.
